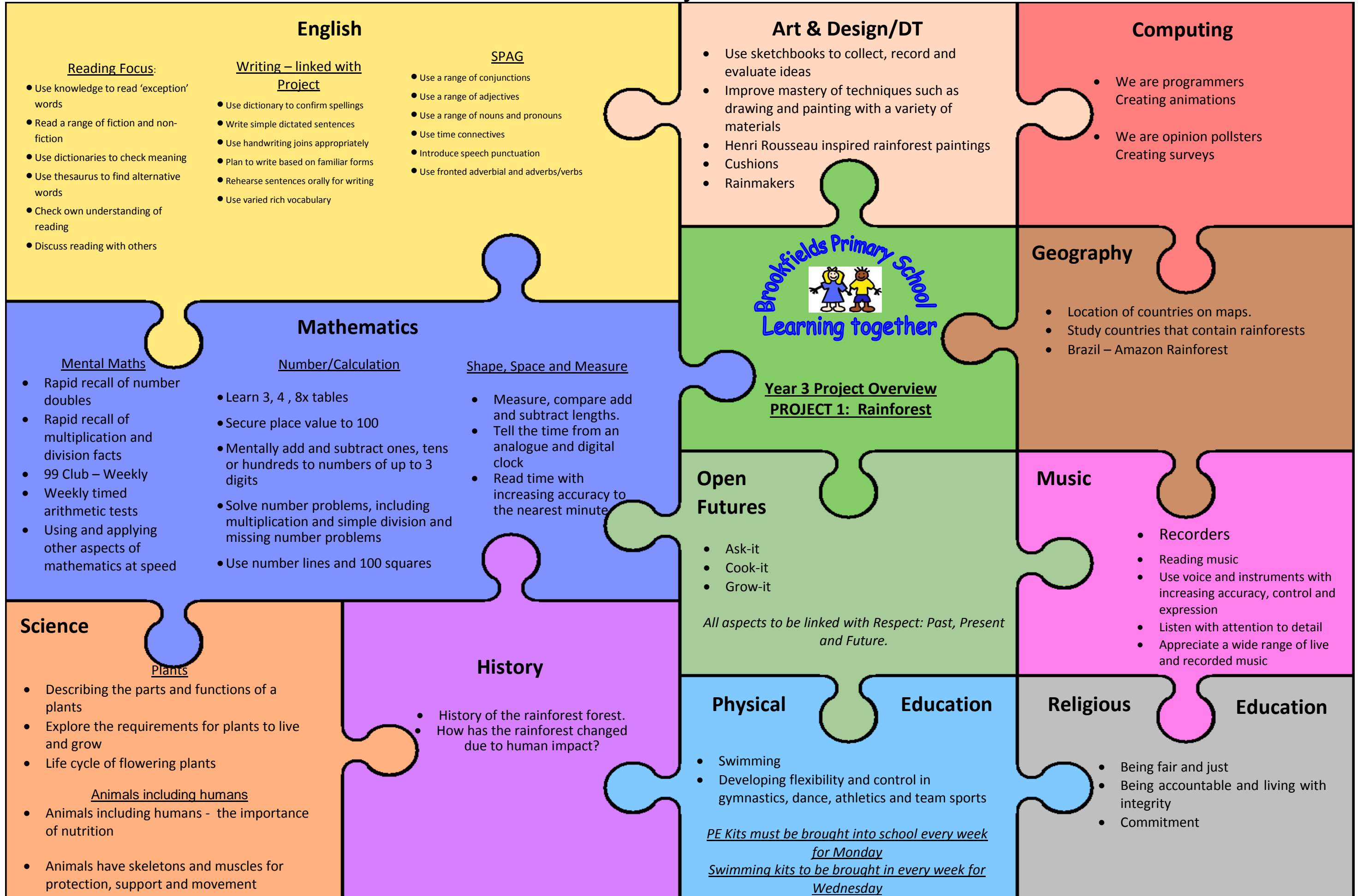


Year 3 Class Project: Rainforest
